Procedures, Rules and Regulations

Sections

17 & Under

15 & Under

13 & Under

11 & Under (no finals)

Ages are determined as at 31/12/2026

(We reserve the right to restrict the number of teams entered by any Association in each section if we have too many entries) Entries will be accepted on “First in Best Dressed” basis.

Entry Fee - \$110.00 per Team to be paid

no later than Saturday 28th Feb 2026

Preferred payment method is via Netball Connect - Team Registration process.

Once we have your registered EOI from google doc, a link will be sent to complete formally in Netball Connect.

1. Teams cancelling prior to 28th February will pay a \$50 processing fee per team. Teams withdrawing after 28th February 2026 will forfeit their entry fee.

Player Eligibility

Players must be current registered members of Netball Victoria or NSW.

Players may only play for one (1) team throughout the day and be of eligible age as at 31/12/2026.

To be eligible for Finals a player must have played with that team during the preliminary matches on that day.

Teams playing ineligible players may be eliminated from the event.

Registration

All registered teams must report to the Tournament Office by 8.00am.

Umpiring

Each team entered must supply a non-playing badged umpire with their own whistle. Please supply umpires who are suitable to the standard they are umpiring.

Please register your Umpires via the following link by 19/3/26 :

Umpire briefing 8.15am.

Matches

Games commence at **8.30am**.

Two seven (7) minute halves, timed by a central siren with a warning siren before each match.

At half time players change ends and play on the umpire's whistle after the siren.

The player Substitute Rule may be utilised as per Netball Victoria Rules of Play.

No injury time, however, the umpire will allow time for an injured player to be replaced.

Late Start

No team shall take the court with less than five (5) players.

Any team not ready to take the court at the scheduled starting time of their game shall:

- i) Forfeit two (2) goals for every minute late;
- ii) Forfeit the game if the team fails to take the court within three (3) minutes of the scheduled starting time.

Score Sheets

The first named team has the centre pass and the second named team has the choice of end. This excludes Finals when the centre pass will be determined by a coin toss.

Each team is to provide a scorer – the two scorers should stand together and use the score sheet provided.

The winning team is responsible to take the scorecard to the tournament office **immediately** after the completion of the match.

Drawn Games

Fixtured Games – Teams will take two points each.

Final Games

- i) At the end of the game, when the scores are tied, there is a one (1) minute break during which time there may be substitutions and/or team changes.
- ii) At the end of that minute, 2 x 4-minute halves are played.
- iii) At the end of the first four (4) minutes teams simply change ends and there are no substitutions or team changes allowed.
- iv) If, at the end of the second four (4) minutes the scores are still tied, then play continues until one team has a two (2) goal advantage.

Finals

There are NO finals for the 11 & Under section.

Finals structure will be determined by entries in each age group.

Each player will receive a medal of participation.

Trophies

Ten (10) medallions per team will be awarded to the winners and runners up

First Aid

St John's Ambulance will be in attendance all day, in the dedicated First Aid Room (located in the Amenities Block. No pregame strapping is available.

The Association will not be responsible for any injuries incurred on the day.

Refreshments Available - Please advise your teams. (Cash & EFTPOS facilities)

A Coffee Van at the Courts for your coffee/hot drink needs.

Canteen facilities will be available during the day selling hot dogs, pies, sausage rolls, sandwiches, fruit, drinks and sweets.

There will also be a BBQ for Bacon & Egg Rolls in the morning and Hamburgers & Sausages in bread for lunchtime run by the Albury Representative players.

We also have some sponsors set up tents selling merchandise.

Other:

If the weather is extremely cold, 11&under players can wear a long sleeve top under their dress that corresponds to dress colour.

Provisional draws will be available through Netball Connect on the Friday before our Tournament. Late changes may occur.
